Introduction and overview.

Streetlight UK provides a specialised support service for women involved in prostitution across Sussex, Surrey and London. We support women and help them overcome the challenges that limit their choices: such as the lack of education, training and employment opportunities as well as the physical and emotional barriers before them. As a volunteer there are many ways to get involved such as assisting with fundraising events, undertaking research, online outreach support, on-street outreach support and contributing to the vision to provide hope to women involved in prostitution.
