OFFICE DRESS CODE:

- No revealing clothing to be worn. No lowcut tops, thin straps or short skirts/shorts.
- Little or no makeup.
- Minimal jewellery so as not to arouse competitiveness.
- Casual but presentable clothing should be worn as per office dress code.

EVENTS/PARTNER MEETINGS/POLICE OPERATIONS DRESS CODE:

- Proper attire should be worn according to the purpose of the event. Please enquire with your line manager for more information, should the event be formal.
- No revealing clothing to be worn.
- Casual but presentable clothing should be worn as per office dress code for partner meetings.
- During police operations and prison meetings shoewear or clothing that could be seen as aggressive or threatening should be avoided.
